I cannot believe that we are entering 2024 already. I am sure that for a few weeks I will still put 2023 on checks and try to remember where a couple of the last twelve months have gone! I hope that you all have had a great holiday season and that 2023 was a good year and that 2024 is even better.

We are very excited about the progress made in 2023 at Riverhill. The resurfacing of the tennis courts with the addition of pickleball courts, the moving of the fitness center into Turning Point, the brand-new swimming pool facility with additional upgrades coming. The painting of most of the clubs' outbuildings and continued plans to upgrade, paint, and find new uses for the old fitness area. A complete renovation of the Cedar Crest room and the Eleven-Straight in the mansion, along with the outdoor patio, which has proven to be a great place to relax and enjoy a great meal with fellow members, and watch golfers on the range, putting green or coming off the ninth green.

Extensive work has been done to the irrigation pumphouse on #4 with a new fertigation system to be added in the spring. Irrigation boxes and new irrigation heads are also on order which will allow Cash the ability to gain more control of when he waters and give him the ability to add nutrients and wetting agents directly through the irrigation system. Let's not forget the bunker and tee project as well. After a somewhat slow start, the project flew along through the summer. Many of you have commented on how well the bunkers play and the fact that it is great playing from level tee boxes! The golf course conditions going into this winter are far better than last year and we feel very confident 2024 will be a great year for golf at Riverhill.

We are also listening to the membership and working with our suppliers on menu options throughout the club. Chef Chase has been tasting, experimenting, and tracking sales in order to offer our membership some new and some proven options that will be featured on our new menu coming early in January. Along with the new menu, we are

packing the 2024 calendar with new member events in food and beverage, golf, tennis and pickleball. If you have participated in an activity that you feel would be great for us to try, please bring it to our attention so we can see if it is a fit for Riverhill. As always, please watch for emails and postings on upcoming events.

The entire staff would like to thank our membership for a good 2023. Hot weather and construction at times were trying, but as the staff reiterates, we have the most loyal members and for that we are thankful. Our 2024 goals are lofty but attainable. Our member referral program continues to be the best way to grow our membership and introduce those friends and business associates to what we feel is the best country club in South Texas.

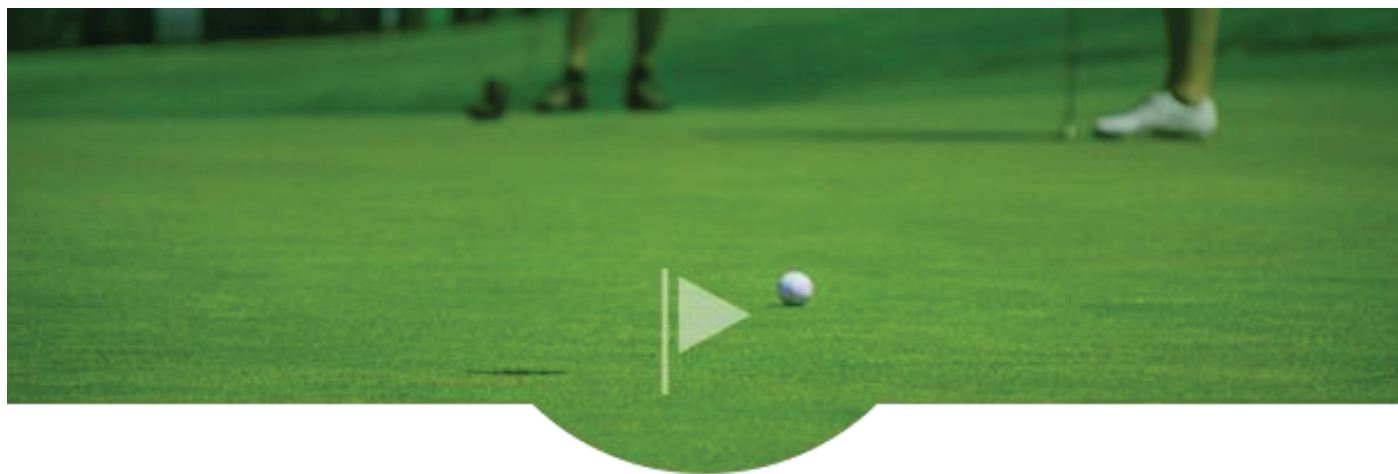

Thursday afternoons at 1:00 pm, Kyle has been running a skins game. Entry is \$40 and skins are both gross and net along with closest to the pins. If you would like to play, please sign up by close of business on Wednesdays.

**Junior Golf Camps:** Cost \$150 per child per session, includes lunch and swimming each day. May 29<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup>, June 12<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup>, June 18<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup>, June 25<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> and July 10<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>. Topics covered include: Full swing, short game, putting, rules and etiquette.

Our first club event of 2024 is The Team Putting Championship. It will take place Saturday afternoon, January 27<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 pm. We will transform the greens on the course into a putting course and the format will be a 2-person scramble. The entry will be \$30 per player including prizes, call the golf shop to sign-up.

This is a good time of year to look at your grips. Grips should be changed out once a year and twice a year for golfers playing twice a week or more. The golf shop has plenty of grips in stock and if there are special ones you would like we can order them for you. If you would like the golf staff to evaluate them for you just bring them by. Turnaround on grips is typically about a day.

TaylorMade and Callaway will be releasing their new products in February, and we will do preview demo days. The TaylorMade spring dates are Friday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> and Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup>. Callaway will be Tuesday, February 20<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup>. Keep in mind we offer a trade-in program that allows you to return your old golf clubs for credit book and the credit can be used for merchandise purchases in the golf shop.

Our 1<sup>st</sup> MGA event of 2024, the MGA Mixer will be Saturday, Jan. 20<sup>th</sup>. The format is an ABCD scramble with dinner afterwards. All club members are welcome to play and can learn more about the MGA and RWGA.

If you are a business owner and looking for logoed product we can order custom golf balls, shirts, and hats for your business or for your tournament outing. Stop by so we can show you samples or help with the order. If anyone has a lead for a golf outing, please contact the golf shop so we can help secure the event. These events are vital to the health of the club, and we can provide golf, lodging and food and beverage.

**From the Desk of Cash Lane**  
Golf Course Maintenance

Greetings all,

I am pleased to make my first announcement to the membership and update everyone on what's happening in the golf course maintenance department. After a brutal stretch of summer, we are pleased with the amount of recovery we made with the Greens and Fairways before winter temperatures set in.

On the Greens, we are making weekly applications of fertilizers, soil conditions, wetting agents and fungicides as needed. Routine top dressing of sand and continual rolling has helped with firmness and smoothness. We recently purchased a new Roller for the Greens that has been a blessing! Venting of the Greens has also been in practice to allow water and oxygen to get to the root zone, poking holes is vital.

More exciting news, we are upgrading some old irrigation control boxes on the course! This will ensure our scheduled watering cycles and make our irrigation system more reliable. Last but not least, we will soon have a fertigation system! This will allow us to inject fertilizers, soil wetting agent and conditioners to clean the pipes, straight into our irrigation system, a game changer.

This time of year, the crew is fighting a battle with all the falling leaves. We are currently blowing and collecting leaves throughout the course and will be for a while. Detail edging is ongoing, edging sprinkler heads and cart paths. Irrigation work is always there and currently depth checking the sand bunkers. Typically, with newly installed sand bunkers the sand tends to move around very easily for awhile until compaction sets in. Daily depth check inspection will continue.



I hope you all have a great time on the course and thank you for your support!
