

Our next club event is the Byron Nelson Invitational May $18^{th} - 20^{th}$. This year we have a record 54 teams signed up. Chef Chase will have some great food and Donna has planned some exciting functions for all the players to enjoy. Kevin and his crew have been working overtime on the course in order to have it in top shape for the event. Extra fertilizing and weed control on the fairways as well as making sure the greens are healthy for the summer and applications to control the weed we had in the greens the last 2 summers.

With the weather getting better and the increased traffic we need singles to pair up, including private carts. Having 3 players in 3 carts and each driving off the path is not good for the turf and until we get the needed rain alleviating traffic from the fairways and roughs will help the recovery.

Thank you to the Tivy and Schreiner golf teams for sanding all divots in the fairways twice this past month.

Our final spring fitting days will be Callaway on Tuesday May 16th from 10-2 and Taylor Made on May 26th 11-3. Both will have all their newest products, trackman fitting technology and is the best opportunity for a custom fitting. Call the golf shop to book an appointment.

In April we hosted the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Men's and Women's Championships. In the 1st round there was a 64 from a Trinity player. Schreiner Men finished 2nd in the event and Yung Gu from Schreiner was the individual Champion shooting 1 over par for 54 holes. The players, coaches and conference staff thank the club and the membership for hosting and support that made their week extra special.

Junior Golf - This summer we will offer two programs.

- 1.) A 6-week program with Boot Ranch and Lady Bird with weekly practices and interclub matches. Details are still being worked out.
- 2.) Junior Golf Camps May 31st June 2nd, June 14th 16th, June 20th 22nd, June 27th 29th, July 12th 14th and July 19th 21st. The cost is \$150 per each 3 day session and applications will be in the golf shop and on the website at riverhillcc.com. Camps run 9:00 12:45. Camps will follow the US Kids Player Pathways program and cover putting, short game, long game, rules and etiquette. Lunch is included and the kids can go home cool and refreshed with pool time each day after camp.

The Course will be open Monday, May 29th for Memorial Day and closed on Tuesday May 30th. Beginning Friday May 26th through Labor Day, the course will open at 7:30 to enable more players to get out earlier and beat the heat.

We are finalizing the golf course improvement projects for the summer which include bunkers and tee boxes. As we have more exact details we will publish to the membership but the expected start date is between May 22nd and June 1st.

The President's Cup chaired by Sharon Smith was a fabulous two days on March 24 and 25th!


