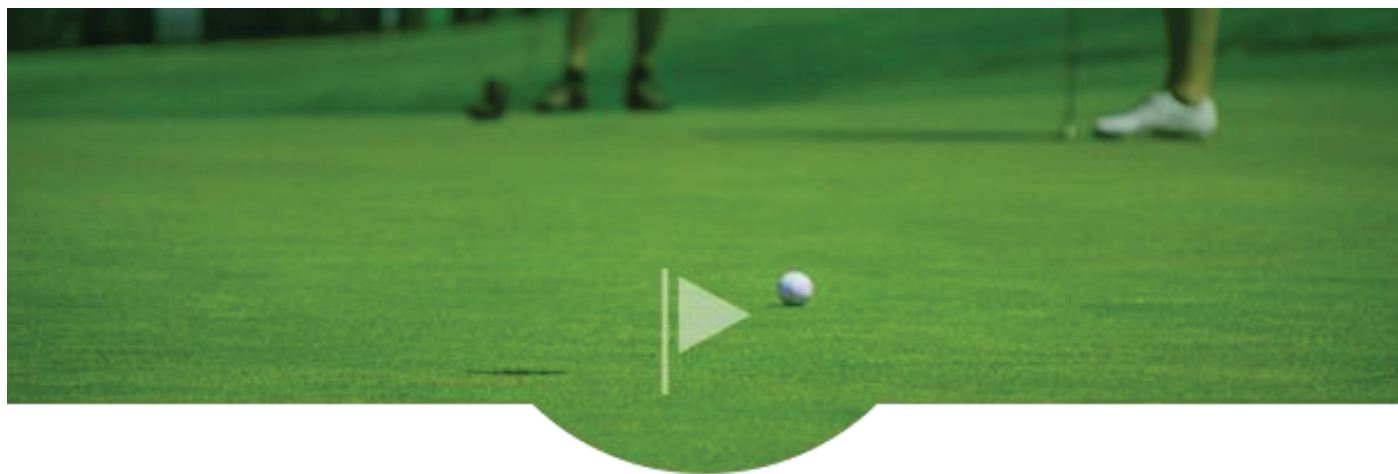

The new bunkers and tee boxes are growing in well and we are anxious for everything to open later in September.

With the renovations we will have the course rerated this fall and will be using a temporary card until we receive the new ratings. The ratings will include course and slope ratings as well as individual hole ratings.

Our Jr. Golf clinics will start back Wednesday Sept. 6th and classes will be at 4:00 (9 and under) and 5:00 (10 and over), and continue till Nov. 15th. Garry won the Men's 55's Doubles ITF World Tennis Championships held In Portugal with his partner Polo Cowan from California. Garry and Polo won 4 rounds and won the finals convincingly 6/1 6/3 over opponents from South Africa. In the singles draw Garry won three rounds before losing the round of 16 to the #7 seed from Sweden.

With this win Garry is now ranked #1 in the ITF World mens 55's doubles and currently is #14 in singles

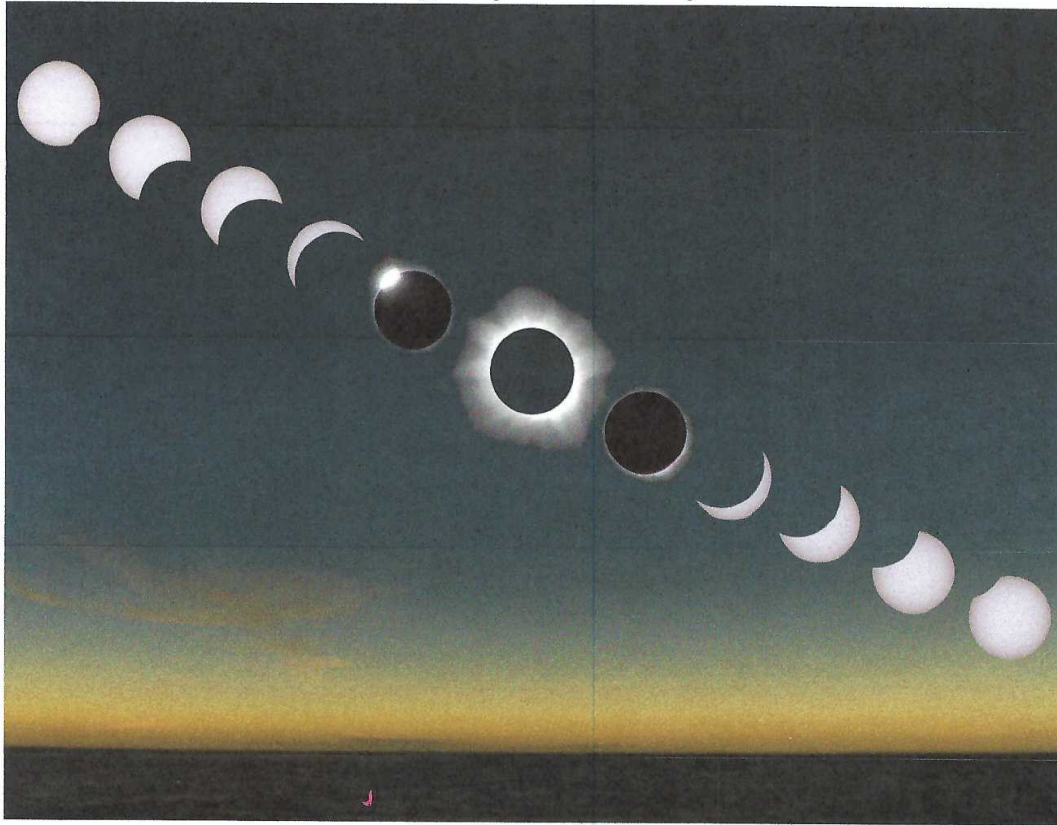
