Introducing Riverhill Country Club's New General Manager Mr. Franck Mannechez



Golf

Don't forget Valentine's Day will be here before you know it. The golf shop is stocking back with all new 2022 products from TaylorMade, Callaway, FootJoy and Sun Mountain, as well as demo clubs.

We had a medical emergency on the course in January. Luckily the players in his group started CPR and called 911 which saved his life. In case of emergency, the club has AED units in the Golf Shop and Turning Point. Also, we have reached out to the Red Cross to setup some staff and member CPR training, dates and times will be announced once confirmed.

Our next club event will be the Par 3 Challenge, Saturday February 19th, 3:00 shotgun. The format is individual stroke play, will be flighted by handicap and there will be gross and net prizes. We will transform the course into 18 Par-3's taking advantage of angles and areas that are not normally seen. The yardages will be between 50 - 125 yards, so everyone is able to play.

Our Jr. Golf Program starts up February 9th. Clinics take place on Wednesdays, ages 9 & under at 4:00, ages 10 & over at 5:00. If you have juniors or know juniors that would like to learn how to play have then contact the golf shop and come out to the clinics. There will also be a monthly play day for on course work. Applications are available on the website or in the golf shop. We will now base our structure along the US Kids Player Pathway program.

Fitting Days scheduled this spring are Callaway on Tuesday February 15th 11:00-3:00 and TaylorMade February 26th 11:00-3:00.

Want to learn how to play golf?? There are several ways, contact Matt for more information. We have loaner equipment, so you don't even need equipment to start.

Golf Course Reminders: Sand your fairway divots and others in the fairway, repair your ball mark as well as any others, cart path only on Par 3's and keep all 4 tires on the path around greens and tees. Your help with all of these will help provide the best turf conditions come springtime.

Golf Tip of the Month:

Check your grips. If there is any shine to the rubber or wear on the synthetic part bring them by the golf shop for new ones, turnaround time is generally 2 days.

February Golf Course Updates

For the month of February, the cart path only holes will be #4 and #14.

Last month the bare areas on #3, #10, #13 and #14 greens were resodded. Also, stumps were ground around the course and are considered abnormal ground conditions till repaired in the spring.

Tree removal and canopy raising will be this month.

Greens will be aerified Feb. 21st & 22nd, course will reopen at 10:00 on the 23rd.

As the course goes dormant it is very important to continue limiting the number of carts off the paths. 1 cart for 1-2 players, 2 carts 3-4 players, this really makes a difference, and we appreciate your cooperation.

Ropes and stakes will continue to be used to give weak areas time to recover, please keep carts out of those areas. Please keep all 4 tires on the path around the greens and tees, it really does make a difference.

As always, please help us by repairing your ball marks, sanding divots in the fairways.
