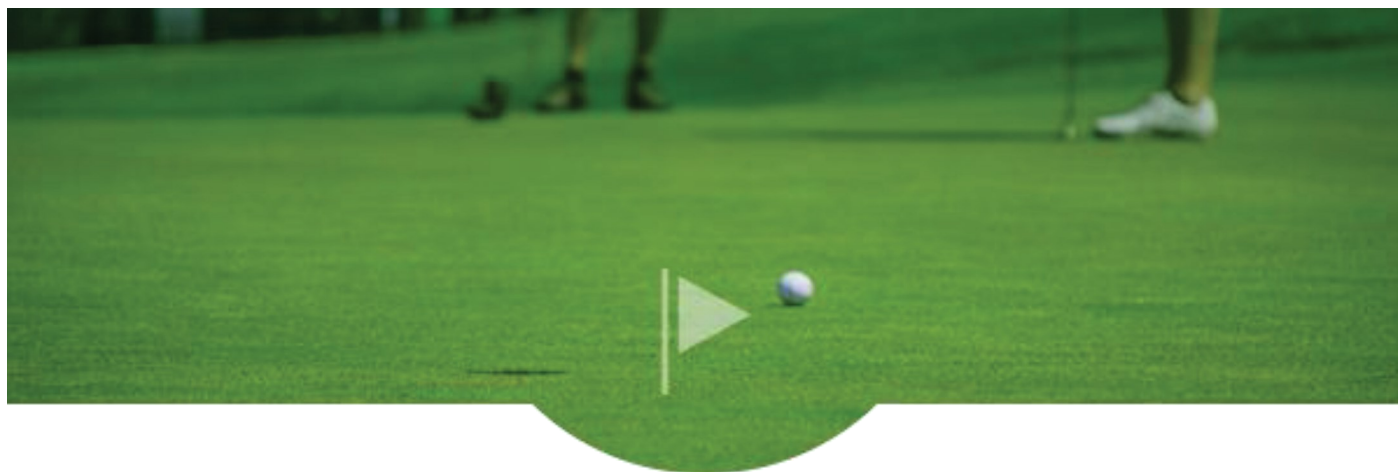

Our annual Firecracker Scramble will be Saturday July 2nd at 8:30. Teams will be 4 players and you can make your own team or sign up individually. Family or friends may play on a team for the appropriate guest fee. Entry fee will be \$30 cash and payable the morning of the event. Currently we have 12 teams signed up and there is room for 24.

The club will be open on Monday July 4th in observance of Independence Day and closed on Tuesday July 5th.

Around the club you have probably much more Jr. Golf activity. We have hosted 4 Junior Golf Camps and also our Jr. Team practices on Wednesday's. Our last summer camp is July 12th-14th. The Jr. Club Championship will be July 21st and the Parent – Child tournament will be July 30th.

A big thank you to Trevor and the course maintenance crew for all their efforts thru the drought. The greens are excellent and they are arriving early and staying late to get as much water on the fairways as we can. Please help us get thru this by pairing up in carts and driving as little as possible on the fairways. Water will be running in the fairways during play and we will be watering greens each afternoon. When the flag is out of the hole please yield to them, getting the water out in a timely fashion is vital to the greens health.

Our cart path only holes for the month of July will be: #5 and #13. Also, the course is closed on most Monday's. Maintenance uses that time to do their chemical spraying. Please stay off the course as you do not know what has been sprayed earlier in the day and could cause greens damage by tracking chemicals. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

With the summer heat please make sure to hydrate before you come out to play. Ice chests have been placed beside the water coolers and the course and we are refilling water coolers in the early afternoon. Also, ice cold towels are available by 18 green to help cool off after play.

June Golf Course Updates

For the month of July the cart path only holes will be #5 and #13

We are experiencing severe drought conditions and are putting out as much water as we can to help get us thru. We need everyone's help pairing up in carts, using the 90 degree rule and to limit driving in the fairways as much as possible. Every little bit helps with the grass so stressed, we appreciate your cooperation.

We will be running fairway sprinkler heads during the day and will need you to play thru them. Also we will have to water areas on the greens and ask that you wait for the staff to finish before playing to the green. The staff will work backwards to try to avoid interfering with a groups play multiple times but this is time sensitive especially on hot dry days.

As always, please help us by repairing your ball marks, sanding divots in the fairways and most of all by keeping your carts on the paths as much as possible. Using the 90 degree rule by driving down the path to your ball and back to the path to drive to your next shot makes a big difference. As does keeping all 4 tires on the path around greens and tees.
