

The golf course projects include enhancements to the pump house on #4 for increased coverage around the course, leveling of tee boxes and renovations of bunkers. Invitations for the Byron Nelson Invitational will be emailed out March 1st. Sign-ups will be taken March 1st - 17th. If the numbers of sign-ups exceed 42 teams, the teams will be ordered by length of membership. This year's dates are May 18th - 20th. The entry is \$975 per team. The format will be round robin four ball match play and the field will be limited to the first 42 teams. Once the 42 teams are determined a \$475 nonrefundable deposit will be issued to the member accounts. Chase and Donna are already hard at work preparing ideas and menus to make this the best Byron so far. Entry fee includes 2 dinners with band and open bar for the spouses, players meals during golf, trophies for Overall and Flight winners are ordered and a player gift. This is a great event with fantastic food and events. It is a great opportunity to show your guest all Riverhill has to offer.
