

The tee box and bunker renovations have started. Throughout the summer there will be hole closures as they move around the course completing the work. Currently holes 3 & 4 are closed and we are starting all play off #10. This will change day to day, and it will be important to check in daily for course status. Rounds played will still get posted as 18-hole rounds over the summer, the scores you take on the holes closed will be net pars.

Summertime means Junior Camps, below is the schedule for this year's camps:

All camps will run 9:00 am - 12:45 pm daily.

Camps will cost \$150 per junior and includes a hat, lunch each day and swim time after lunch. Entry forms are in the Golf Shop and on-line.

We are also having a Jr. Golf Team that will compete in (3) Jr. Scrambles at Riverhill, Boot Ranch and Lady Bird. Team practices start on Wednesday June 14th and the first event will be June 24th at Lady Bird. Practices and play days will run through July 22nd.

The Riverhill Team Championship begins June 20th. Two-person teams will compete in flighted best ball match play competition. Matches will be round robin within the flights, so each team is guaranteed 2 matches. Each hole will be worth a point and the team with the most points advances out of the flight. Space limited to the first 24 teams, so don't delay. Any holes closed during a match will be halved.

Do you know about the Hole-in-One club? For \$5 if you make an ace at Riverhill with a witness all the members of the hole in one club get billed \$5 and the pot goes onto your credit book account for future purchases. Currently the pot is almost \$550.

The course and practice areas will be closed June 6th & 7th and reopen Thursday June 8th at 9:00, due to greens and fairway aerification.

Big thank you to Kevin and his crew, the course is really looking good coming out of the drought. The recent rains have helped and hopefully more will be on the way throughout the summer.

Summer is almost here. To get more players out early the course will open daily at 7:30 through Labor Day. Please remember to start drinking water before you come out to play.
