The entry is \$925 per team. The format will be round robin four ball match play and the field will be limited to the first 42 teams. With the increased demand to play and to allow everyone enough time for members to arrange their guest, there will be a \$200 non-refundable deposit to be on the list. Franck and Chase are hard at work preparing ideas and menus to make this the best Byron so far. Exit 505 and Collectors Edition have been booked for our evening functions, trophies for Overall and Flight winners are ordered and Tommy Bahama camp shirts are on the way.
